<u>Databases & Indexes:</u> http://umb.libguides.com/az.php for more general research:

- 1. From the Healey Library homepage click on Databases & Indexes
 - Note: off-campus access will prompt users to enter their last name and library barcode
- 2. The landing page for Databases & Indexes is the complete A-Z list of library databases
 - Scroll down for Academic Search Complete, or...
 - Select "E" and scroll down for EBSCOhost Databases, or...
 - Select "J" for JSTOR, etc.
- 3. On a database search screen, enter your **search terms** into the box:
 - e.g. "college students" AND stress
 - Advanced Search can limit results to articles available in Full-Text only, in Peer-Reviewed Journals, by Date Range, by Subject; or search for your terms within specific parts of the article, e.g. Author, Title, Abstract, etc.

<u>Interlibrary Loan (ILL):</u> http://www.umb.edu/library/interlibrary loan Request free materials that are <u>not</u> available in the Healey Library catalog or through the searchable databases:

- For books, e-books, printed or scanned book chapters, printed or scanned journal articles, films, and other materials <u>not</u> available at Healey Library, submit a request to Interlibrary Loan (ILL)
- Electronic documents are delivered to ILL user accounts and physical items to the circulation desk for check out – for <u>free</u> (borrowing and renewal periods vary by lending institution).
