The scholarship award is \$2,500!

Eligibility Requirements

- g Be of Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity as defined by the U.S. Census (www.census.gov/population/race/about).
- g Be a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or a citizen of the U.S. Freely Associated States.
- g Be enrolled as a full-time student in a degree-seeking program at the University of Massachusetts Boston during the 2014 Spring Semester.
- Applied for federal financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Applicants do not necessarily need to be recipients of federal financial aid to be eligible for a scholarship from APIASF. Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov for more information.

Additional Notes

- Full-time enrollment and degreeseeking status are defined by the guidelines set by the institution's Office of the Registrar.
- Students who already have a bachelor's degree are NOT eligible to apply.
- When you apply, you can be a part-time student; however, you must be enrolled full-time upon receipt of funding.
- Solely online students are not eligible to apply. If you are enrolled in online and on-ground courses, no more than 1/2 of your courses can be online.

The application deadline is October 11, 2013, at 9 p.m. EDT.
